Venue

How to get here

By train

Regular services operate between Sheffield and London St. Pancras (from just over 2 hours), Birmingham (1.25 hours), Leeds (1 hour) Manchester (1 hour) and Nottingham (1 hour). There is a direct link from the railway station to the Sheffield Station Supertram stop. Depart the tram at 'University of Sheffield' or 'West Street' station.

By car

The University recommends using one of the park and ride schemes in operation (consult link below). At the university, there are two car parks: Durham Road at the Western Bank end of the city campus or Solly Street, which may be more convenient if you are visiting the Broad Lane or Mappin Street areas. Spaces can be pre-booked at either car park.
